How To: Install VPN Client Software on Mac OS 10

- Quit all running applications and browse to the Cisco VPN section of https://software.lbl.gov
- Download Cisco VPN 4.9.01.0100. (Mac OS 10.3 users, download Cisco VPN 4.7.00.0510.)
- The file will be called vpnclient-darwin-4-2-2.9.01.0100-universal-k9.dmg (Mac OS 10.3 users, the file will be called vpnclient-darwin-4.7.00.0510-GUI-k9_with_pcf.dmg.)
- If the disk image is not mounted automatically, double-click this file.



• Double-click the Cisco VPN Client file to begin the installation process.



• You will be presented with a prompt to begin installation.



• Click **Continue** on the next dialog.



• Click Continue if you agree with the license agreement to continue installation.



• Click Agree to proceed.



• Choose your system disk where the software will be installed and click **Continue**.
